

GST related relief measures during COVID-19 lockdown



Government of India has announced multiple measures in order to mitigate hardship caused to the GST taxpayers and all related stakeholders during the period of restrictions, lockdown and social distancing, imposed to contain the spread of COVID-19 virus. Measures are as follows: -

1. Procedural and Tax relief granted with respect to GST compliance.

a. Relaxation in mandatory compliance under GST for filing of returns, payment of taxes etc.:


